- Cloud computing

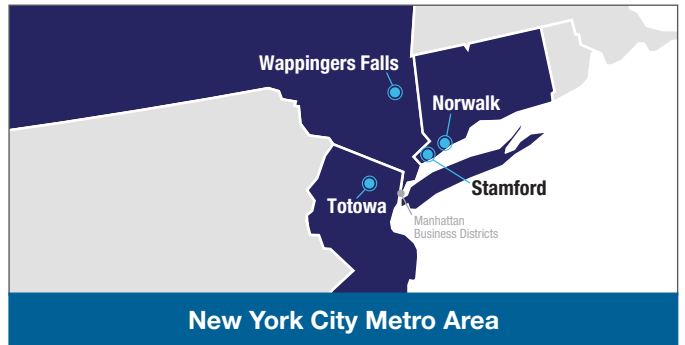
Key Capabilities

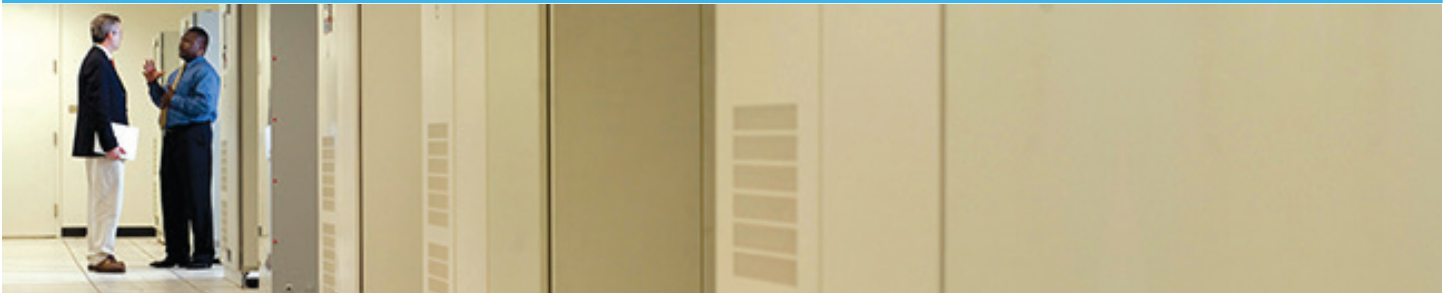

- Carrier-neutral facility with two MDF rooms provides dual access to multiple providers for flexible connectivity
- Building and all critical equipment are above 500-year flood zone
- Comprehensive fire protection system
